

**** St. Rose of Lima Parental Notice ****

Dear Parents:

Upon registering your child in the St. Rose of Lima CYO Program (SRL CYO), please be aware of the following conditions, rules and regulations governing our CYO program:

- * The registration fee is \$75.00, to be paid in full at the time of registration. **ONLY CASH AND MONEY ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Also, a mandatory fundraiser will be collected at the time of registration. Fundraisers vary by sport. Once a registration card is filled out, there are no refunds on the \$12.00 card fee.
- * There is a uniform fee of \$35.00. You will be able to keep your child's uniform. Each team will have a specific date and time for measurements. You must show up to that scheduled time. (uniform price subject to change per sport)
- * **There is no guarantee that your child will play or practice in Zone 1. If you have multiple children participating in CYO, there may be a possibility that their schedules will conflict. We are not responsible for conflicting schedules.**
- * Your assistance is needed and required with the concession stand and other duties associated within the CYO program. Under normal circumstances, two (2) hours **ARE REQUIRED** for each child registered in the current season. A service hour deposit of \$35.00 is required. The deposit check will be cashed if you have a no show or do not fulfill the 2 service hours. The secretary will post the available hours on the website.
- * The 3rd Sunday of each month is designated as CYO Mass. You and your child are encouraged to attend this mass at 11:00am, unless the child is attending RE class. This will be verified through Sister Cathy. Teams with 100% attendance will be rewarded. Players **MUST** wear the jersey **TUCKED IN** and must sign in with a board member.
- * For the safety of your child, you are expected to attend practice together. **CHILDREN ARE NOT** to be left at practice without a parent or responsible adult. Parents must pick up their children promptly at the end of practice. Religious Education classes and church functions have priority over practice/games.
- * A medical consent form, service hour form and registration card must be signed by the parent or legal guardian.
- * All coaches, parents and players are expected to abide by the code of conduct set forth by the Chancery. The Code of Conduct requires all coaches, parents and players to refrain from using profanity, displaying anger, being dishonest or behaving improperly or unchristian. Violations will result in suspension from the CYO program. Trash at all fields must be thrown in the garbage. Outside food, drinks or alcoholic beverages are not allowed at any gym. Team snacks can be left in your vehicle. Fines of \$25.00 per team will be assessed if this is not followed. We reserve the right to drop a child or team at any time at the discretion of the CYO Parish Board without a refund.
- * There is a \$100.00 fee per team for no shows to any scheduled game within Zone 1. No show Zone fees vary if you are not playing in Zone 1.

The SRL CYO meetings are held on the 3rd Thursday of each month, but are subject to change. We need and strongly encourage parents' attendance and participation in the CYO meetings and activities. Also, refer to the church bulletin or website for additional information regarding our meetings and functions.

SRL CYO Executive Board is committed to providing your child with a wholesome athletic experience firmly grounded in the beliefs of the St. Rose of Lima Church.
